Acts 20-28 summaries:

Acts 20: Paul encourages the Ephesian elders, bids farewell, and begins his journey to Jerusalem despite warnings of impending danger.

Acts 21: Paul travels to Jerusalem, where he faces opposition from the Jewish leaders, and is warned by the prophet Agabus about his impending arrest.

Acts 22: Paul defends himself before the Jewish crowd in Jerusalem, recounting his conversion and calling, but is nearly killed after mentioning his mission to the Gentiles.

Acts 23: Paul appears before the Sanhedrin, narrowly escapes a plot to kill him, and is transferred to Caesarea for his safety.

Acts 24: Paul is tried before Governor Felix, who postpones the verdict and keeps Paul in custody for two years, hoping for a bribe.

Acts 25: Paul appeals to Caesar after being unjustly accused, and Governor Festus seeks advice from King Agrippa on how to proceed with his case.

Acts 26: Paul gives his defense before King Agrippa, recounting his conversion and mission, leading Agrippa to almost become a Christian.

Acts 27: Paul embarks on a perilous sea voyage to Rome, survives a shipwreck, and is ultimately stranded on the island of Malta.

Acts 28: Paul survives a snake bite on Malta and heals the sick there... and then goes to Rome.
